Footnotes

MACEDONIAN raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to win going away. RYS ALLEY CAT raced three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, moved up to make a bid near the three-eighths pole, tied three then two wide on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch, bumped with SPELL outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while just able to get the place. FIRST CROWNED raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and finished well to just miss the place. TIZ BIZ raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace between rivals, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased while off the rail on the far turn, battled willingly in the stretch but lacked the needed kick and missed the minor awards. RIKKI TIKKI TAVI lingered towards the rear of the field, moved out on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with good late energy. LEGAL CITIZEN was well placed just off the pace, came under urging on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. SPELL raced just off the pace while between rivals, moved up while four then three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, battled with RYS ALLEY CAT into the final furlong, bumped with that rival outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened. BIG BUFF raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced five then four wide on the far turn, chased the leaders into the final furlong and tired. BIG JUMP settled towards the rear of the field, was ridden along on the final turn and failed to rally. POWERED BY CAT raced four wide on the first turn, contested the pace, steadied while dropping out near the quarter-pole and gave way. NOBIZLIKEHORSEBIZ raced off the rail on the first turn, contested the pace, came up empty while inside on the far turn and faded. GOLD STAR ALERT raced four to five wide on both turns and was outrun. (Rail at 0 Feet)
